# KIDS PARTIES WIN AT CLUBS & COMMUNITY AWARDS

At the 2024 NSW Clubs & Community Awards last month, Twin Towns Board Directors were thrilled to accept the major award in the Social Inclusion category, which recognises outstanding Clubs that are dedicated to supporting those with additional needs.

Twin Towns winning entry - All Abilities Come to the Party - told the story of the annual Kids Parties hosted by the Twin Towns Services Community Foundation for the past 19 years for local kids.

Almost two decades ago, the Twin Towns Community Foundation recognised how sometimes children with additional needs struggled to be accepted.

Although preschool and school-aged children regularly attended parties throughout their school years, heartbreakingly, many kids with additional needs seldom received an invitation.

Twin Towns changed all of that, with children in the local community, along with their parents or carers and their siblings, receiving an invitation every year to attend the biggest free, fully catered kids party in the Tweed Shire.

Since it all began, over 4,000 kids have 'come to the party' at Twin Towns.

Club Director David Phillips said winning the Social Inclusion Award was a huge accolade for Twin Towns.



"All the Directors are immensely proud to win this award as it really highlights the role of Twin Towns within our local community.

"I think everyone across New South Wales should be proud of their local Clubs because they all contribute to their local communities in so many unique and thoughtful ways," he said.

Twin Towns looks forward to seeing hundreds more smiling faces at their next Annual Kids Party in August.

The Twin Towns Services Community Foundation is Twin Towns' philanthropic arm, which funds worthwhile projects in the community, over and above what is provided through ClubGRANTS.

# TWO TO SEE AT THE TAVERN

Get behind Aussie pro boxer Sam Goodman when he defends his mandatory undisputed super bantamweight world title against Chainoi 'Rock Man' Worawut on 10 July.

The 25-year-old from Albion Park returns to the ring just three months after a dominant 4th round KO win over Mark Schleibs.

Successfully defending his number-one ranking across the IBF and WBO gave him a title shot against superstar Naoya Inoue.

Aiming to spoil Goodman's homecoming is Thai fighter, 26-year-old Worawut (25-0-1). Worawut is ranked #8 in the WBC rankings with an impressive 15 wins by way of KO.

Head to the Tavern on Sunday 28 July to see current welterweight champion, Englishman Leon Edwards, defend his title against American Belal Muhammad in the main event at UFC 304.

At almost 33 years of age, 'Rocky' Edwards recently admitted that age is crucial as it impacts physical performance. He says his plan is to retire at 36 or 37, leaving the sport as the greatest welterweight ever.

In the meantime, Edwards will face Muhammad. Their previous encounter at UFC 278 resulted in a

no-contest due to an accidental eye poke by Edwards in the second round.

It's no secret these two aren't the best of friends. Ahead of the announcement of this matchup, Muhammad was quoted in media as saying, "I hate Leon Edwards' guts, he's trying to avoid me but I'm next, no matter what".

He also claims the Edwards camp refuse to acknowledge him as a number one contender.

Unbeaten in his last 10 fights, this may be Muhammad's moment to prove them wrong!

Blokes Beers & Banter is open to all male club members, non-members, holiday makers and locals.

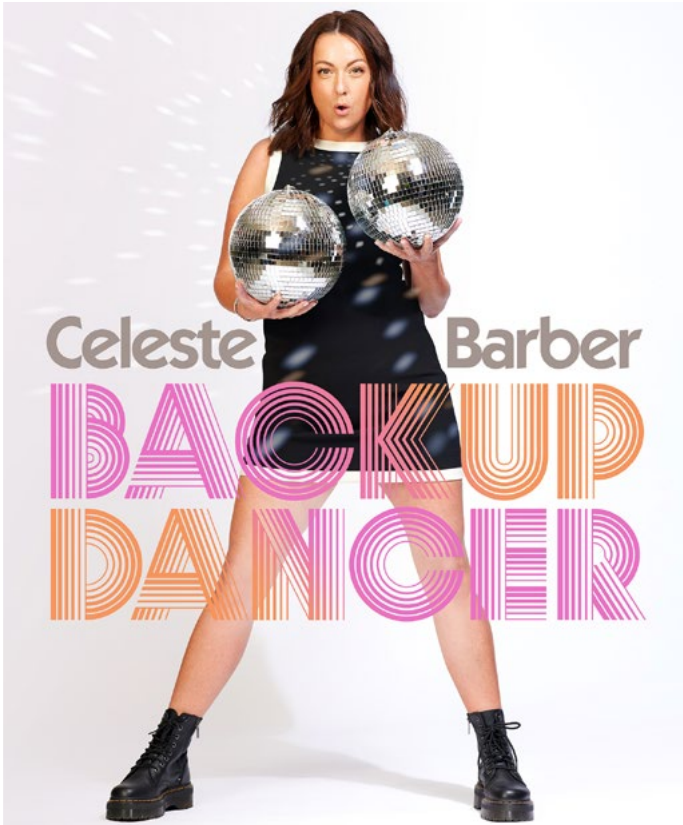



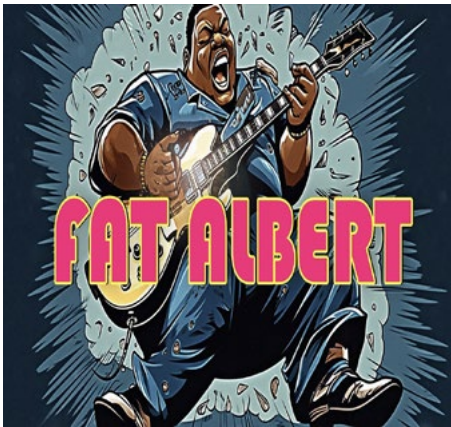
