CLONTARF ACADEMY'S TOP TRAINERS

Throughout the year, students from the Clontarf Academy at Tweed River High School are treated to 'Top Trainers' breakfasts at Signatures at the Resort before heading off to school.

They earn the privilege for outstanding attendance at early morning training sessions throughout the school term.

The Clontarf Foundation is an organisation that aims to improve the education, discipline, self-esteem, life skills and employment prospects of young Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander men.

Their Academies work in partnership with local schools across Australia, focusing on attendance, behavioural change and positive attitudes, which leads to students completing school and finding secure employment. Since Twin Towns provided \$20,000 to fund the enrolment of 10 students in 2023, the Tweed Academy has grown to 69 boys. More substantial growth is predicted over the next 12 months.

Board Director David Phillips is "Over the moon" with the growth of Tweed River High's Clontarf Academy.

"Leaders of the local program - Cameron, Lucas and Adam – deserve congratulations for their engagement and training of these young men.

"Manners, responsibility and good discipline are always on display whenever the students visit the Club.

"I look forward to observing their continued development and sincerely hope that we can continue to support Clontarf in the future," said David.

SOUS CHEF CHRIS RYAN HAS ADDED SOME DELICIOUS DISHES TO THE HARBOUR FRESH MENU THIS MONTH FOR OUR SEAFOOD AND MEAT-LOVING DINERS.

Two new entrees are available including everyone's favourite, oysters! Chris' Oysters Normandy features fresh local oysters with brandy crème, gruyere and panko crumb.

Be adventurous and try the Kangaroo Tataki. This tender, pepper-crusted fillet is served with pickled pear, radish, watercress and roasted sesame dressing.

Starring on the mains list is the Tweed Coast Sri Lankan Prawn Curry, pictured above.

Made with local king prawns, this dish

combines a complex blend of spices and aromatics that reflect the authentic flavours of Sri Lankan cuisine.

The prawns are oven-roasted in a rich sauce with fresh curry leaf and native spinach and garnished with pickled tomato. The dish is served with sesame flatbread so you can savour every last drop at the bottom of the bowl.

The second main will make a pair of steak-lovers deliriously happy! It's an 750g Delmonico T-bone, grilled with Creole oyster butter and served with French herb salad and hand-cut truffled parmesan fries. Although it serves two people, this American-style feast could also be a very memorable meal for one!

If you can fit it in, finish off with the Fresh Berry Compote, with a mix of fresh berries, pistachio gelato and caramelized white chocolate.

And there you have it - a pageful of reasons to visit Harbour Fresh this month.

NIKKA WHISKY NIGHT

Still & Barrel's first Nikka Whisky Night on 22 August sold out in record time but if you're quick, you can still snap up one of the last spots for the second one on Wednesday 21 August.

Guest speaker, David Macklin from Nikka Whisky, will introduce you to the Nikka brand, which was founded in 1940 by the 'Father of Japanese Whisky', Masataka Taketsuru (1894-1979).

In 1918, Taketsuru ventured alone to Scotland to learn the secret of whisky making. He became the first Japanese person ever to master the art.

He enrolled at the University of Glasgow, took chemistry courses and apprenticed at three Scotch distilleries. He learned first-hand from craftsmen and the two notebooks he filled with every detail later became Japan's very first guide to whisky production.

Taketsuru chose Yoichi, Hokkaido, as the site for his first distillery. Nikka's second distillery is Miyagikyo.





His highly successful solo career included a #1 ARIA Album Chart for Edge (1988) featuring the hit singles As The Days Go By and One Summer.






